Today's Message: Palm Sunday - Preparations For Easter

Luke 19:29-40

Palm Sunday, also known as Christ's Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem, marks the beginning of the Passion Week. Orthodox Churches have a Cross with a black or purple band on it. People fast the week attending Mass and Prayers day and night. Unfortunately, believers who are born again show very little or no importance to observe Easter. People take time off their work to show their love and commitment to Christ's Crucifixion, Death and Resurrection.

I. The Lord Has Need of a Colt

Luke 19:30-35; 19:9, 10; John 4:31-34; Matthew 9:35-38; Jeremiah 50:6; Ezekiel 34:6; Luke 14:15-24

Jesus Christ has the ownership of all things, yet he needs a Colt to ride on. The main need of Jesus is for Souls to be saved. His mission is to get all mankind saved.

II. Jesus Rides on the Colt

Luke 19:35-38; Mark 11:7-10; Luke 7:36-38; Proverbs 3:9; Psalms 29:2; 34:3; 57:5; 107:32

Christ was being honored, as he rode on the Colt. Jesus uses human instrumentalities and the disciples acclaimed Him King. We need to honor Christ our Savior and King with our time, talent, substance and everything. Let's come together to celebrate Easter.

III. Jesus Demands Your Praise or Nature Praises

Luke 19:39-40; Matthews 11:28-30; 10:32,33; Psalms 65:13; 69:34; 98:8; Isaiah 44:23
