Today's Message: The Power in United Prayer

2 Chronicles 7:14

God delights in United Prayer of His People. United Prayer, also called Co-operate or Social Prayer is very powerful. God's Word says, "One will drive away a thousand, but two will drive away ten thousand." Just as the family that prays together stays together, so is the Church of God. Someone will say, "United we stand, divided we fall."

I. Co-operation is Essential for Success

Ecclesiastes 4:9
