**Today's Message: Conscience Void of Offense**

**Acts 24:16**

Conscience is that part of our soul that has to do with the real nature and quality of our thoughts, words and actions. It also has to do with rule, whereby we are to be directed, and the agreement and disagreement of the norms of the society.

**I. Work of the Conscience**

*Romans 2:15; 13:5; 1 Cor. 8:7; Heb. 9:14*

God has given man conscience to either accuse or excuse us from our actions, words or thoughts. Before the law and the Bible, God judged the people according to their conscience.

**II. Dead Conscience**

*1 Tim. 4:2; Deut. 1:43; Isaiah 28:12; 2 Pet. 2:10*

People with dead conscience are those with hardened hearts, self-willed, or those who have their conscience seared with hot iron. They have no regret or remorse for their bad actions.

**III. Guilty Conscience**

*Gen. 3:10; 42:21; Ex. 9:27; Ezra 9:6; Ps. 40:12; Dan. 5:6; John 8:9*

One feels condemned of his thoughts, words, or actions when he / she has a guilty conscience. Sometimes one becomes ashamed.

**IV. Good Conscience**

*Acts 24:16; Rom. 9:1; 2 Cor. 1:12; 1 Tim. 1:5, 19; 1 Pet. 3:16*

Children of God, we are required to have a conscience always void of offense toward God, and man.
