## Today's Message: Naomi

### I. Naomi as a supportive Wife

Ruth 1:1 – 2

1. She stays with her husband and children in good times and bad times.
2. She did not know what was ahead but she took the initiative out of love for her husband and children.

### II. Naomi as a good Mother in law

Ruth 1:6

1. She kept her daughter in law with her in difficult times. She loved them so much that they wanted to go with her to Israel.
2. She did not ask them to go back out of hatred but love.
3. She seeks the best for Ruth: She encourages Ruth to go after Boaz (Ruth 3:1 – 2).
4. A mother gives instructions to her children (Ruth 3:3 and 4).

### III. Naomi as the perfect Grandmother

Ruth 4:16

1. The Lord restores her – she loses both sons, but now holds the perfect son in her laps.
2. Our responsibility as grandmothers should not be limited to nurses. We can always find different ways to love.
