Today's Message: Alter Your Altar

1 Kings 18:25 - 40

True worship of God requires an altar. Individual Christians, as well as the body of Christ, are crying for personal renewal and true revival when the altars are broken. All mankind has an altar and except one has the right altar of the Lord, one cannot see the expectable revival.

I. Worshipping on the Wrong or False Altars

1 Kings 18:25 – 29; 12:26 – 33; Genesis 4:1 – 5; Revelation 12:7 - 12

False altars and false ways of worship have been in existence since the fall of man. Jesus talked about the false prophets and teachers of his days. The book of Revelation talks of the false Prophet that will come on this earth w/ great signs & wonders. Exodus 7:11, 22; 8:7; Revelation 13:13, 14; 16:14.

II. The True Altar of the Lord

1 Kings 18:30 – 35; Genesis 8:20 – 21; Exodus 20:24 – 26
Altars are built for worshipping God. There were laws regarding the building of the Lord's altar, and the altar must not be broken. Before we can worship God acceptably, the broken altar must be repaired. We cannot offer sacrifice on a polluted altar, nor on an altar below God's acceptable standard and pattern.

III. The Altered Altar Brought Fire

1 Kings 18:36 – 40; Hebrews 13:10 – 15; Malachi 3:3; Hosea 10:12

When the Altar of the Lord was repaired or changed, God always answered. Jesus has promised to answer our prayers when we have the right altar and the right sacrifices.
